## **Swab and Media Shortages**

Laboratory Bulletin

Beaumont Laboratory continues to face critical supply chain shortages of swabs (e.g. white ESwabs) and media used for routine bacterial cultures. To circumvent the white ESwab shortage, Beaumont Laboratory will be providing white and red BBL<sup>TM</sup> CultureSwabs<sup>TM</sup> as an alternative for specimen collection. A specimen collection guide for the most common test orders is listed below. To prevent media shortages, alternative vendors and methods have been utilized by Beaumont Laboratory to keep testing in-house for a quicker turnaround time. However, some providers may experience delays in test results due to intermittent media shortages.
