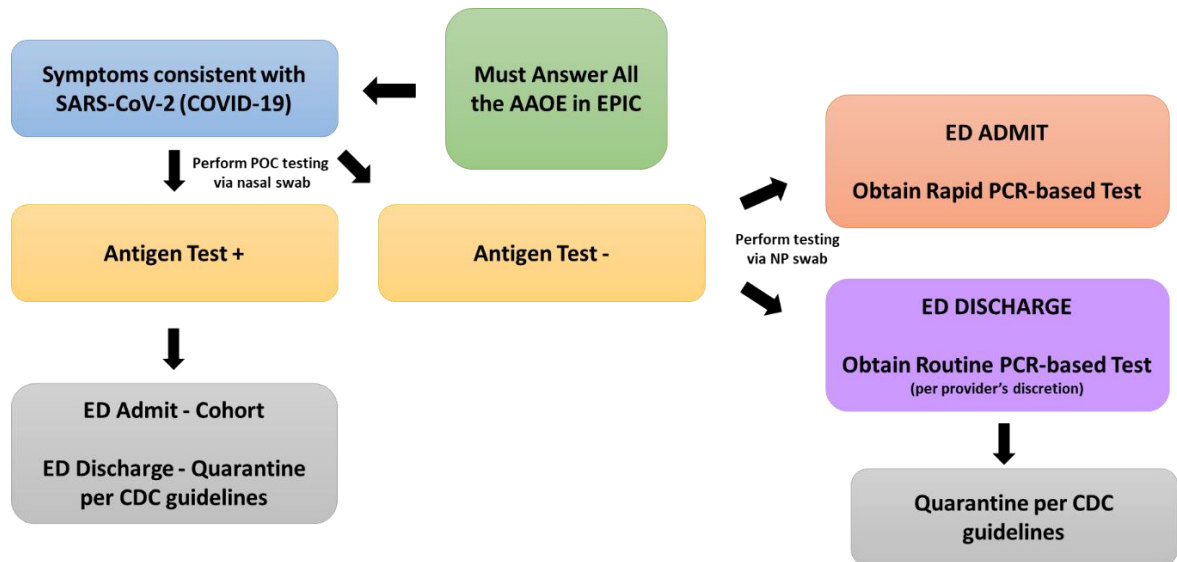


SAR-CoV-2 Antigen Test, Point of Care, Emergency Centers

Effective Date: November 23, 2020

Beaumont Laboratory will be deploying SARS-CoV-2 point of care **antigen** testing in emergency departments across the system to combat the rise in COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations. The SARS-CoV-2 antigen test is a 15 minute test that can diagnose COVID-19 in **SYMPTOMATIC** patients. Providers must order the test in Epic oneChart and answer order-entry questions required by the state. A positive SARS-CoV-2 antigen test in symptomatic patients should be considered a true positive, and results do not need to be confirmed with a PCR-based test. Negative results from symptomatic patients should be treated as presumptive negative and followed up with a PCR-based test, if necessary. The proposed workflow for SARS-CoV-2 antigen testing is shown in the chart below.
