

Hematopathology Subspecialty Consolidation

Effective Date: August 15, 2021

Beginning August 15th, all hematopathology specimens (bone marrow, pathologist consults, peripheral smear reviews, and lymph nodes that need to be signed out by the hematopathology group such as, but not limited to, lymphomas/rule-out lymphomas) will be sent to the Beaumont Laboratory subspecialty hematopathology group for interpretation. By moving all hematopathology to one site we are creating a single group of subspecialized experts who only sign out hematopathology. This allows for collaboration among experts and onsite access to ancillary testing such as: flow cytometry, cytogenetics and molecular laboratories that are located at Royal Oak.

No changes are occurring to orderable test codes or specimen requirements for any specimens included in this consolidation. All bone marrows collected in a physician office should be called to Beaumont laboratory customer service, at 800-245-3725, Option 1, so that a stat courier is deployed.
