## Maternal Serum Screening Report – Addition of ONTD Risk and Report delivery changes

Screens include: Maternal Serum AFP, Quad screen, Integrated and Sequential screens and First trimester screen.

- An ONTD risk (1 in .....) will be reported whenever an AFP is part of a maternal serum screen. An
  increase in risk is based on an AFP MoM of greater than 2.20
- The original signed maternal serum report will NO LONGER be delivered to physician offices but instead will be FAXED on the weekday following report finalization.
- Abnormal reports will continue to be called and faxed as soon as possible after report review.
- Serum marker and NT MoM's and risk assessments will still be available in Epic-Beaker.
- The complete report will still include patient information used for risk assessments, such as LMP, gestational age, weight, diabetic status, race, smoking history, etc.
- Epic EMR users will still be able to view a scanned copy of the original report in Epic and will also receive a FAX copy.
- Non-Epic EMR users will <u>not</u> have the scanned report available to them but will receive a FAX of the complete report.
