

PSA (Prostate Specific Antigen) Test Change

Effective Date: Nov 15, 2023

Effective 11/15/2023, all total PSA samples from men between 40 and 49 years of age will be tested at Corewell Health East Royal Oak Laboratory instead of being sent out to Mayo Clinic Laboratories. Total PSA samples on men equal or greater than 50 years of age will continue to be tested at Corewell Health East Laboratories, and the samples for men less than 40 years of age will continue to be tested at Mayo Clinic Laboratories. Reference ranges for each age group are indicated in the following table:

Total PSA	Reference Range (ng/mL)	Performing Laboratory
Men <40 years old	≤ 2.0	Mayo Clinic Laboratories
Men 40-49 years old	≤ 2.5	Corewell Health East Royal Oak Laboratory
Men ≥ 50 years old	≤ 4.0	Corewell Health East Laboratories

Free PSA orders (including total) (LAB7158) will continue to be tested at Mayo Clinic Laboratories for men under 50 years of age, and will be tested at Corewell Health East Laboratory for men equal or greater than 50 years of age. Please note, for total PSA values between 4.0-10.0 ng/mL a reflex to free PSA will occur.
