### PSA Test Change (Prostate Specific Antigen)

Effective Date: October 2, 2023

# Laboratory Bulletin

Due to regulatory issues, all PSA samples on men less than 50 years of age will be referred to Mayo Clinic Laboratory for testing, effective October 2, until further notice.

This includes both total prostate specific antigen (tPSA) for screening (LAB5106) and diagnosis (LAB5105), and Free PSA (including total) (LAB7158). Please note, for Free PSA (including total), reflex to free PSA will occur for total PSA values from 4.0-10.0 ng/mL.

**Please note: Results will be scanned into the patient's chart as a miscellaneous lab test.**
