Hematology Resulting Updates

Effective Date: July 30, 2025

Corewell Health Laboratories will be aligning the hematology middleware (Caresphere) among all regions. Below are the resulting updates for CHE (Corewell Health East):

Red Blood Cell morphology grading changes from 1+, 2+, 3+ to few, moderate, many: Acanthocytes, Echinocytes, Elliptocytes, Maco Ovalocytes, Hypochromasia, Polychromasia, Schistocytes, Blister Cells, Bite Cells, Spherocytes, Stomatocytes, Target Cells, Tear Drop Cells.

Schistocyte review order grading changes: none seen, few (<1), moderate (1-2), many (>2).

Ovalocytes name change to Elliptocytes.

New Macro Ovalocytes category. Grading moderate (2-5) and many (>5).

IPF (immature platelet fraction) will display within the CBC portion. IPF will result every 24 hours when platelet is less than 100 x 10*9/L.

When appropriate criteria are met, a manual differential reflex or an RBC morphology reflex will be resulted.

IRF (immature reticulocyte fraction) unit change from ratio to percentage. See reference range table below.
