

# Beaumont

Hello,

Thank you for your inquiry about the **Beaumont School of Medical Laboratory Science 44-week clinical laboratory education program!** This program is designed for **post-baccalaureate, non-MLS degree candidates.** We accept 18-20 students per class. The next class will tentatively start in **Fall 2022** or **Winter 2023.**

Applicants must be **highly motivated, self-directed learners** who will be able to commit to a rigorous 44-week, full-time program (Monday-Friday) consisting of a dedicated lecture series in the first half and clinical laboratory rotations in the second half of the program. Students who successfully complete the program are eligible to apply for the **Medical Laboratory Scientist** certification exam offered by the [American Society for Clinical Pathology Board of Certification](#) and seek employment in numerous clinical laboratory disciplines.

## ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS:

- U.S. equivalent of **B.S. degree**
  - Major in MLS, Health Science, Microbiology, Biology, Chemistry or Biochemistry preferred
- **GPA of 2.8 or higher** – both overall and in degree-specific courses – to be verified by submitting official transcript(s) from universities attended
- Completion of the following baccalaureate-level courses within the last 7 years:
  - **Foundations in Clinical Laboratory Science – CDS 4900**
    - This course is offered Fall and Winter through Oakland University.

  - 16 credit hours in CHEMISTRY including:
    - **BIOCHEMISTRY** and **ORGANIC CHEMISTRY** courses **with laboratory**
  - 16 credit hours in BIOLOGY including:
    - **GENERAL MICROBIOLOGY with laboratory**
  - **MATH** (intermediate algebra or higher)
  - **PHYSIOLOGY** and
  - **STATISTICS** (preferred)
- Additional skills: Microsoft Office – Word, PowerPoint, Excel – plus Internet/email applications
- Permanent U.S. resident or authorization to work in the U.S.
- Good faculty and/or employer recommendations (three)
- Previous work experience (required)
- Meet the approval of the MLS Admission Committee to ensure GPA and university coursework meet both program admission and certification agency requirements. *Note: Substitutions to the above academic requirements may be permitted upon review of academic transcript and personal interview.*

## APPLICATION:

## ADMISSIONS:

- The 44-week Medical Laboratory Science program accepts **16-20 students per year.**
- **Applications** will be accepted **April 1 through August 15.**
- **Interviews** will be conducted **June 1 through September 30.**
- MTIMPM Student Match Registration forms must be postmarked by **October 5.** Interviewed applicants will be notified of the match results in **early November.**
- **Tuition is \$5,000** and will be due one week prior to the program start date.
  - Tuition may be waived for a 2-year work agreement. Contact program director for details.
